In October 2012, The Corso at North Lakes, a \$45 million development funded by Moreton Bay Regional Council and the Australian Government, became the first local government public building project to achieve a 5 Star Green Star – Public Building PILOT Design rating

In the past, public buildings have tended to be large consumers of energy and quite often operational costs will be offset with the funds generated from activity such as rents. Although The Corso at North Lakes includes a commercial office component, it is designed and built to deliver significant savings in energy and water running costs for council.

TROX chilled beam type DID632 are used throughout the commercial floors on the project and have been configured to deliver a highly flexible space conditioning solution.
